Alabama, not Navy, finished second to Army in the final Associated Press poll to determine the country's top ten football teams, a re-check of the 116 votes cast showed yesterday.

A tabulator's error on the lone first-place vote for Alabama sent the midshipmen into the runner-up slot, with the Crimson Tide in third place. A re-count furnished the following results: Army 1,159 points, Alabama 942, Navy 941.
